He does work, but does not contribute financially to the household as he has some significant behavioral issues as a result of his illness. Her other son was a volunteer firefighter but had to terminate his work due to increasing medical concerns related to diabetes. Kathleen is retired and on a fixed income with no financial help. She also has some health issues; she developed COPD as a result of chemical exposure from her previous work as a laboratory histologist. She is an active member of her church community and donates time to the Douglas Elbert Task Force.

## The scope of the work needed includes:

- Yard work (clean up and landscaping)
- Fence replacement
- Tear down and disposal of old pool and shed in back yard
- New hard surface in kitchen with extension to back door
- Carpet cleaning throughout the upper level of the home
- Minor exterior touch up paint
- Gutter clean out
- Tree trimming → It would be very beneficial to have tree service a day ahead to remove over growth of trees and brush
- Repair or replace exterior light fixtures
- Exterior brick repair
- Likely additional trash haul-off
- Kitchen appliances (if we can find some used that are in better shape than hers to be donated)
- Deck repair
- Garage door repair
- We need use of a Bobcat
- We need use of a Wood Chipper

## Measurements taken at Kathleen's:

- Range 30"
- Fridge 36" (did not check height)
- Dishwasher 24"
- Kitchen floor 9'x20'
- Fence: Front section 20 feet is 2"x6" now but could change to 2"x4"
- Left side 53 feet we thought this just needed repairs some sections are hard to tell with over grow 2"x4"
- Rear 87 feet Dan thought we should replace most of this it is 2"x4"
- Right side 35 feet also needs some repairs 2"x4"
